FEATURED SCHOLARSHIPS

The UNCF/Koch Scholars Program — is a renewable program which offers up to \$5,000 a year, the program is an educational initiative that explores how entrepreneurship, economics and innovation contribute to the well-being of individuals, communities and society. Students may be African American high school seniors or college freshmen with a minimum 2.7 GPA majoring in Accounting, Business, Economics, Engineering, History, Philosophy or Political Science.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Foot Locker Foundation, Inc.-UNCF Scholarship —offers up to \$5,000 for students attending a UNCF member HBCU or university during the fall of 2018. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and may be high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomore, college junior or college senior.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

The UNCF STEM Scholar Program – is a renewable program that offers **high school seniors** with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students must major in Engineering, Mathematics, Science and Technology, the program provides \$2,500 for freshman and sophomore year, \$5,000 for junior and senior year and additional \$5,000 for fifth year. Students must be African American and a citizen of the United States.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2018)

Galactic Unite Bytheway Scholarship —offers up to \$7,500 for female high school seniors attending a 4 year college or university majoring in STEM. Students must have a minimum 3.2 GPA.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Catherine W. Pierce Scholarship offers a \$5,000 scholarship to students who are majoring in disciplines within Arts and or History and have a 2.5 GPA. Students may be a high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomore, college junior, college senior or Masters Student.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Cleveland Metropolitan School District Scholarship - offers a \$12,000 scholarship to students who are graduating seniors in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and must be high school seniors enrolled full-time at a U.S. Accredited 4 year college or university or an approved 2 year college.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Coca-Cola First Generation Scholarship offers a \$5,000 scholarship to students who are first in their families to attend a 4-year college or university. Students must attend an UNCF Member HBCU institution in the Atlanta Metro area: Morehouse College, Spelman College, Clark Atlanta University or the Interdenominational Theological Center. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and may be college freshmen, college sophomore, college junior or college seniors.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Colgate-Palmolive Corporate Scholars Program - offers an internship/ scholarship to African American students who are majoring in Accounting, Business (Sales Interest), Business-related, Chemical engineering, Economics, Electrical Engineering, Finance, industrial Engineering, Information Systems, Marketing, Mathematical Statistics, Mechanical Engineering, Statistics, Supply Chain Management and Logistics, Systems engineering. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and must be college juniors or college sophomores enrolled full-time at a U.S. Accredited 4 year college or university or an approved 2 year college.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Cooper Industries Program — The UNCF and Cooper Industries is offering the Cooper Industry Scholarship to support engineering and business students at accredited 4 year colleges and universities. Students must have a 2.75 GPA minimum and must be college freshmen, college sophomores, college juniors or college seniors studying Business or Engineering.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Jay Charles Levine Scholarship - The Jay Charles Levine Scholarship will provide a \$3,000 tuition scholarship for freshmen students from the state of Michigan. Applicants must be a resident of Michigan with at least a 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale, and must be enrolled at a UNCF Member HBCU as a full-time student. Student must provide 3 letters of recommendation of which one must be written by an instructor who can speak to the applicant's academic rigor. Students must be college freshmen.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

John Lennon Endowed Scholarship Program - Provides a \$5,000 scholarship support to deserving students attending UNCF Member HBCU institutions. Students must be majoring in Communications, Mass Communications, Mass Media Arts, Music and Performing Arts with a minimum 3.0 GPA and may be a college freshmen, college sophomores, college juniors, college seniors and 5th year seniors.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Liberty Mutual Insurance Leada@Liberty Scholarship Program - Offers a \$2,500 scholarship to Massachusetts students who are high school seniors or college freshman attending Massachusetts State University or University of Massachusetts institution. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Margie H. Verbal Emergency Scholarship Fund - Is designed to assist graduating in spring 2018; and who experience an emergency financial need. Students must have a minimum 2.8 GPA. Attend a UNCF Member HBCU in North Carolina with a major in Engineering or Education.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

The Michael Jackson Scholarship – Provides financial assistance to communication arts and social science students attending a UNCF Member HBCU. Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 2.5, the scholarship will provide an award up to \$5,000. Students may be college freshmen, college sophomores, college juniors, college seniors, 5th year seniors and Masters Student.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

NBMOA Hospitality Scholars Program - Applicants must be U.S. citizens majoring in restaurant / hotel / hospitality management, accounting, business or marketing as full-time students at an accredited Historically Black College or University (HBCU). Students must have a minimum 2.8 GPA and may be college freshmen, college sophomores or college juniors.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Northwest Indiana Scholarship Program - Northwest Indiana Scholarship Program provides up to \$5,000 need based scholarship awards to selected applicants from Northwest region of the state of Indiana. Students who are permanent residents of Lake, LaPorte and Porter Counties are eligible for this scholarship. Students may be high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomores and college juniors with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Ossie Davis Scholars Program - Provides up to \$6,800 in scholarship awards to high school seniors interested in studying African America Studies, Communications, Education, Fine Arts, Political Science, Social Science Theater Arts/Drama or Visual Arts. Program requires a minimum GPA of 3.0.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Ralph and Fanny Ellison Scholarship - Provides up to a \$10,000 award to students from New York. Students can be college sophomores and college juniors with a minimum GPA of 2.5 majoring in English or Music.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Betha M. Ford Scholarship for English Majors - Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. The scholarship will provide an award up to \$5,000 depending on the financial need of the student as verified by the attending University or College. Students may be high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomores, college juniors, college seniors or Masters Student with a minimum GPA of 2.5 studying English.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

Rhythm Nation/Janet Jackson Scholarship - The Rhythm Nation/Janet Jackson Endowed Scholarship is open students at UNCF Member HBCU institutions who are Communication Majors. Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. The scholarship will provide an award up to \$5,000 depending on the financial need of the student as verified by the attending University or College.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

The Blanche Ford Endowment Scholarship Fund – Provides up to \$10,000 in need-based scholarship awards renewable through university graduation. Students can be a college sophomore with a minimum GPA of 3.0 studying at a UNCF Member HBCU.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

USA Funds - Provides up to \$5,000 in need-based scholarship awards to students enrolled at UNCF Member HBCU or university or a state college or university in Indiana. Students may be high school seniors, college freshmen, college sophomore, college junior, college senior and 5th year senior with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

Anthem (Wellpoint) Corporate Scholars Program – Is a nationwide workforce initiative that creates career opportunities for minority students. The program will provide scholarships up to \$5,000. Students must be a junior and major in business, communications, marketing, finance, computer science, information systems and management information systems and computer technology.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

UNCF/Carnival Corporate Scholars Program – Provides a paid summer internship with two-year commitment at Carnival Corporation with a two year renewal scholarship up to \$5,000. Students must be a college sophomore with a minimum GPA of 2.75 and major in Business, Communications, Culinary, Finance, Hospitality Administration, Hospitality Management and Marketing.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

United Health Foundation Diverse Scholars Initiative – Has established a multi-year renewable scholarship program open to students attending UNCF Member HBCU. Students may be college sophomores or college juniors with a minimum GPA of 3.0 majoring in behavioral health, biochemistry, biological sciences, biology, biomedical research, biotechnical health, medicine, nursing, pharmacy, public health or radiology.

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Spring 2018)

Walton- UNCF K-12 Education Fellows Program –

The Walton-UNCF K-12 Education Fellowship Program is a leadership and talent development initiative aimed at building a robust pipeline for high-achieving African Americans engaged in education in America. The program selects undergraduate juniors from HBCU's to participate in a leadership development and paid intern placement program that partners with innovative K-12 educational reform enterprises. Students must be college juniors with a minimum GPA of 3.0, enrolled in a HBCU, be a U.S. Citizen or a permanent resident, willing to relocate for the summer. All majors are welcome to apply!

DEADLINE: Annual Scholarship (Fall 2017)

- Submit the required documents
- Address all components of the essay(s)
- Descriptions of activities show impact & leadership
- Recommender form(s) speaks to Program objectives
- Student essay(s) demonstrate a realistic self-appraisal
